  - b. *Interpretation:* As specifically as possible, provide any of the following that appear applicable to each case:
    - Diagnosis of disease or process
    - Characterization of effusions
    - Differential diagnosis
    - Potential etiologies
    - Additional tests you would recommend
4. Limit answers to the spaces provided on the front sides of the following pages.
5. Do not write in the right margin or at the bottom of the page.
6. Questions average 20 points each.
