Before	the meeting:
	Invite your colleagues to join you in New Orleans!
	Post I'm attending, and tag @ACVP, #ACVP2025.
	If you are presenting, brag about it on social media: tag @ACVP and #ACVP2025, post
	I'm presenting.
	Download the ACVP meeting mobile app following links and instructions emailed to registered attendees on October 9. In the mobile app:  O Set up your profile and build your schedule.  O Review speaker handouts, and case histories and slides for mystery slide sessions  O Note scientific posters and exhibitors you want to visit
	If you prefer a paper <u>Scientific Grid</u> detailing concurrent presentations across concurrent sessions, <u>Schedule-at-a-Glance</u> (showing all education, events, and meetings, by day, time, and location) be sure to print a copy before heading to New Orleans. <b>ACVP 2025 Annual Meeting is paperless.</b>
	Watch for your unique QR code registration email (sent two days before the meeting starts) that you will use to check in at the <b>Meeting Registration Desk on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor</b> of the Sheraton (Napoleon Foyer) when you arrive at the meeting.
When	you arrive:
	Bring your registration QR code email to the <b>Registration Desk on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor</b> (Napoleon Foyer) to check-in and get your meeting badge. The badge is required for entrance to all Annual Meeting sessions and events, as well as the Exhibit Hall. Select applicable ribbons to add to your badge to let other attendees know a little about yourself. (See ribbon wall next to Registration.)
	Join us in the Exhibit Hall for the Welcome Celebration on Saturday evening (5:30-7pm) then head out for dinner with colleagues at one of New Orleans's numerous options!
During	the meeting:
	Rise early for yoga (6:30-7:30am, Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday morning) and Sunrise Poster Viewing (7-8am Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday in the Exhibit Hall, with new posters each morning). <i>There will be coffee and tea!</i>
	Maximize attendance in educational sessions to earn up to 22 hours of CE for the Annual Meeting, with concurrent sessions covering topics of interest for every attendee.

	Earn even more CE by registering to attend a pre-meeting workshop on Saturday.
