RESPONSIBILITIES OF A SPONSOR

General: Sponsorship of a candidate is not to be taken lightly; sponsorship is one of the principal indices used by ACVP in determining a candidate's preparedness to sit for the exam.

Sponsor: All applications require a sponsor. The sponsor who endorses the application must be the person most responsible for the candidate's training in veterinary pathology. Occasionally, circumstances dictate that a sponsor is not the principal mentor, in which case the ACVP Board of Directors requires an explanation/ justification.

Phase I Examination Sponsors: Phase I sponsors do not need to be ACVP, ECVP, or ECVCP Diplomates if the candidate is training in the Alternate Route of Phase II training. However, if the 12 months of Phase I training is to be applied to the 36 months of Standard Route Phase II Training, the sponsor must be an ACVP (Clinical Pathology) or ECVCP Diplomate (for Clinical Pathology candidates) or an ACVP (Anatomic Pathology) or ECVP Diplomate by examination (for Anatomic Pathology candidates).
